

Business Manager – The Museum of Scottish Lighthouses

The Museum of Scottish Lighthouses, based in Fraserburgh, is seeking to appoint a proactive and forward looking Business Manager to maintain the current high standards of this nationally accredited facility and to further develop the visitor experience and commercial aspects of the Museum. Reporting direct to the Board of the Limited Company that operates the Museum, the post holder requires excellent business, interpersonal and marketing skills. These skills require to be coupled with the ability to take the lead in all aspects of the Museum's operations and liaison with key stakeholders. Heritage sector and curatorial experience would be desirable to augment the core skills required.

The main Museum building is adjacent to the historic Kinnaird Head lighthouse, which is managed by the Museum on behalf of Historic Scotland. They are set in a scenic rural area of Scotland, yet close to the city facilities of Aberdeen.

The post is full time and the starting salary will be in the range of £30k to £32k.
